

YATES COUNTY RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Recycling collection is done by your trash hauler whether you have your trash collected at your house or take it to a drop-off location. Your trash hauler can give you more information about collection schedule or hours of operation.

Please place all materials in one container.
 No separation is needed.
 Labels may stay on.

Acceptable Materials	
Paper Products: Flatten and stack or pile neatly.	Do Not Recycle these:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cardboard boxes: flatten • Cereal and cracker and gift boxes: flatten • Office paper: white and all colors • Magazines • Junk mail • Newspaper • Envelopes: manila and letter • File folders • Computer paper • Phone books • Shredded paper (in clear plastic bags) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wadded papers • Unflattened boxes • Frozen food boxes and other boxes with wax coating • Juice boxes
Containers: Clean. Remove all plastic tops and discard. Food, beverage, cleaning product & health-care bottles.	Do Not Recycle these:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aluminum cans, foil and pans (pie tins & baking) • "tin" cans: include tops • glass bottles and jars: remove tops and discard • plastic bottles with numbers on the bottom (#1 - #7) • milk cartons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • motor oil containers • caps and tops • plastic bags • plastic cups • Styrofoam egg cartons, cups or meat trays
