PAPER

Clean papers and boxes only

Preparation: Fold and place in Blue Box.

Mix paper and cardboard together in the Blue Box.

We accept:

- Newspapers and Pennysavers
 - Cardboard boxes (food and gift boxes)
 - Telephone books
 - Corrugated cardboard (shipping) boxes
 - Hard cover and Paperback books
- Please take covers off hard-cover books.

Please keep
PAPERS
separate from
CONTAINERS.

SHREDDED PAPER:

Shredded sensitive papers;
bills, invoices, checks.
Put in plastic grocery bag.
Tie shut.

OTHER PAPER: magazines, junk

mail, office paper, envelopes.
Mix together in a grocery bag and
tie shut.

CONTAINERS

Food, cleaning products and personal care products only

Preparation:

- Clean and drain.
- Remove and discard tops.
- Mix together in a clear plastic trash bag or loose in a box.

We accept:

- Glass food containers: clear or any color
- Metal food containers: steel and aluminum cans and foil, including baking pans
- Plastic food, cleaning, and personal care containers with #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 on the bottom
- Paper cartons: milk and juice cartons and drink boxes

- **Recycling crews begin by 6 a.m.**

- **Please place your Blue Box at the curb by 6 a.m.**

Weather-related delays:

Recycling collection is occasionally delayed because of weather-related events. When Wayne County declares a "Travel Advisory" or weather-related state of emergency, the recycling trucks will not complete their routes. Recycling collection will be delayed to the next day. Announcements will be on Rochester radio and television stations if the recycling collection is delayed.

Solutions for materials not accepted in the Blue Box recycling program:

- **Disposal of out-dated and unwanted medication:** Grind pills to powder or empty capsules. Mix with a little water. Mix paste with kitty litter. Dispose in trash. Liquid medication: Mix with kitty litter. Dispose in trash.
- Sharps and lancets must be disposed of appropriately. Never place in Blue Box for recycling. Store safely and take to hospital or nursing home.
- Household hazardous waste: Annual HHW collection in the fall. Watch local papers for more information.
- Electronics: Some companies will accept materials. Usually there is a small disposal fee. Fall HHW collection includes electronics also.
- Leaves and grass clippings, other organic material: Composting is a simple, natural process that will work in almost any yard.
